

## **Teacher Checklist for Do What Writing Prompt Analysis:**

### **Materials Needed:**

- Presentation
- Anchor Charts
- Practice Activity sheets
- Sample writing prompts

### **Implementation Checklist:**

- Understand and explain the purpose of the Do What Writing Prompt Analysis strategy
- Model how to use the strategy with a sample writing prompt
- Break down and clarify each of the five key steps in the strategy
- Provide students with writing prompt examples and analyze them together
- Guide students in highlighting "Do" words with different colors
- Assist students in underlining the "What" in the prompts using another color
- Support students in creating structured analysis sheets for each prompt
- Facilitate pair activities where students dissect prompts and complete analysis sheets
- Assign independent practice for students to analyze their chosen prompt and plan their response
- Encourage students to write out detailed steps for their writing process based on their analysis
- Lead a closing discussion where students share their analyses and reflect on the strategy's usefulness
- Assess student understanding through their completed worksheets and prompt breakdowns
- Prepare homework tasks to reinforce prompt analysis skills outside the classroom
